



Winter Transportation Options/Snow Routes

As winter approaches it is important that we prepare to deal with the weather conditions that may present problems in transporting your children. Please be prepared for these winter transportation options. These options include:

- a. Schools closed and buses not operating for the day.
- b. Buses operating the usual routes on a delayed time schedule (the normal pattern would be a two-hour delay).
- c. Use of one or all of the Snow Route Schedules.
- d. Buses operating the usual routes at the usual times.

This information would be provided to the following radio stations and television stations by 6:00 a.m. (unless an emergency situation develops later). The radio stations that will be contacted are: KXPC/103.7, KFIR/720AM, KRDI/1610AM, KLOO/1340AM/106.3FM, KRKT/99.9FM/990AM, KSHO920AM, KGAL/1580AM, KEJO/1240AM and participating television stations (KPTV, KGW, KOIN, KATU, KVAL, KMTR, KLSR and KEZI). The information is also provided on the District website at www.lebanon.k12.or.us under “school closure/news alerts”. Parents may also subscribe to receive “FLASH ALERT” information via the website.

Please do not call the radio/television stations for information regarding school closure. They will announce the information as soon as they receive it.

Should the need for a **Snow Route** Schedule occur, the following is a list of routes to be used:

Ingram Rd.	Students who live on Ingram Rd will be picked up at the intersection of Hwy 20 and Ingram Rd.
Ty Valley/SW 5 th	Students who live on Larson Dr., Edgemont and SW 5 th will meet the bus at the intersection of SW 5 th and the upper loop of Larson Dr. Those students who live off of Agate Drive will be picked up at Agate and Sodaville Cutoff. Ty Valley students will be picked up at Ty Valley and Deadwood. Students on the lower part of SW 5 th St. will be picked up at the intersections of either Vaughn Ln and SW 5 th or Rockhill and SW 5 th .
Golden Valley/ Hidden Valley/Mt Hope	Golden Valley students between Brewster and Mt Hope will meet at the corner of Golden Valley and Hidden Valley Rds. Golden Valley/Mt Hope students will meet at the intersection of Bellinger Scale and Mt Hope. Hidden Valley students will meet at Mountain Man or Golden Valley.
Mt Pleasant	South of Keel Mt will pick up at Old Mill intersection
Keel Mtn/Edwards	Students who live on Keel Mtn, north of Keel Mtn on Mt Pleasant and Edwards will be picked up at Lcomb Dr and Mt Pleasant.

Ford Mill/Kauffman	HS students that live on Ford Mill/Kauffman will need to meet at Lacomb Store. Bus will not travel Ford Mill for Lacomb students.
Clark Smith	HS students that live on Clark Smith will need to meet at Lacomb Store. Bus will not travel Clark Smith for Lacomb students.
Cut off	Meet either at the intersection of Meridian or at Island Inn.
Griggs	Stops on Griggs between Bond Rd and Providence will meet at Bond/Griggs intersection
Shingle Mill/Green Mtn	Green Mtn and Shingle Mill students will meet at the Island Inn turnaround spot.
Peoples Dr.	Students who live on Peoples Dr will be picked up at the Ede Rd and Peoples Dr intersection.
Santiam Terrace	Students on the South side of Hwy 20 will need to meet the bus in the corner of Hwy 20 and Santiam Terrace.
Upper Berlin	Students who live on Upper Berlin above Jack Creek Lane will be picked up at Jack Creek Lane.
Speasl	Students living up Speasl will need to meet at the Speasl and McDowell Creek intersection.
Pineway	All stops that are on Pineway Dr. will meet at the intersection of Sodaville Waterloo Rd. or Hwy 20.
Middle Ridge/Sodaville	Students living on the East side of Middle Ridge Rd will be picked up at Middle Ridge and Canyon View Rd (this includes Elizabeth Dr). Students living on the West side will be picked up at Brownsville Rd and Middle Ridge Rd. Students living on Sodaville Rd, Sodaville Waterloo, Sodaville Mtn Home, Cottage, Alder, Maple, Westview, St. Charles, etc will meet at Sodaville City Park.
Harrington / Townsend	Students living on Harrington and Townsend will meet @ Pineway & Sodaville Waterloo.

NOTE: Although inclement weather is hard to predict, should the need arise, students are to be at their alternate stops at least 10 minutes before their normal pick up time. Isolated roads may not be passable; drivers will use their own discretion on whether or not to drive any road.
