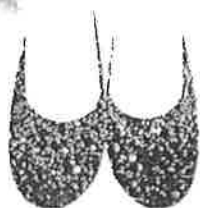

- ✓ Registration forms will be on hand, or you may go to our website.

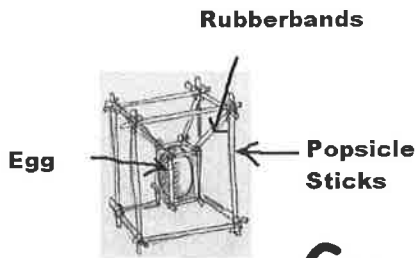

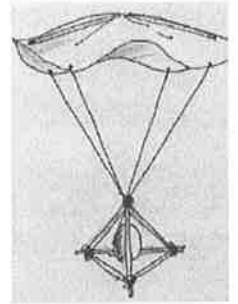

Audacious Asparagus

Recipe

Lemon roasted asparagus

Ingredients

- 2 pounds asparagus
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 2 teaspoon minced garlic
- 2 tablespoon lemon juice

Directions

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Wash asparagus and snap off ends.

Place all ingredients in a Ziploc bag, seal tightly and shake until asparagus is coated. Empty asparagus onto a baking sheet. Bake at 400 degrees for approximately 12 minutes until cooked but firm.

Makes 6 servings.

What's the best way to eat asparagus?

- Roasted
- Grilled during the summer
- Lightly steamed and chopped in a green salad or pasta salad
- Sautéed in a stir fry

Selection and preparation

Selection	Storage
Choose asparagus with tight, compact buds and stalks that are firm and crisp to snap	Store trimmed stems in one or two inches of water. Cover with a plastic bag and refrigerate until you are ready to eat.
Preparation	Cooking
Wash asparagus in cool water and cut off the tough end until you get to the tender part of the stem.	Enjoy raw, steamed, grilled and roasted!

Re-Enrollment: Currently enrolled in Lebanon Community Schools & returning
Enrollment: Brand new to the district

The enrollment process this year is done on-line for next year. We will **NOT** be sending any paper registration packets home so please go on-line via the link on the Green Acres website. If your student is new to Lebanon Community Schools your student is considered a **New Enrollment**. If your student already attended Lebanon Community Schools, then your student is considered a **Re-Enrollment**. Only New Enrollments should create an account. Re-enrollments should use their Pinnacle username. The following options are available for registering your student:

Option 1 (preferred): Register your student(s) online from the convenience of your home. You can save your registration and complete it in more than one session. Call the office at 541-451-8534 if you are needing your Pinnacle Access information or any help with the on-line registration. This information was sent home in the Tuesday folder with the new RegiStar paperwork the first week of May.

Option 2: Attend an open house and register your student(s) online (limited computers available) at Green Acres.

- > May 17th Kindergarten Orientation and Registration 1 – 4:30 PM in the cafeteria
- > May 23rd from 2:30 – 4:30 PM in the cafeteria or computer lab
- > May 30th from 5-7 PM in the cafeteria or computer lab
- > May 31st from 2:30 – 4:30 & 5 – 6:30 PM in the cafeteria or computer lab

ALL Re-Enrollments need to be completed on-line before the end of the school year. Those families who register before June 7th will have their names entered in a drawing for a **FREE** Kindle.

Separate HEALTH FORM: Also, there is a Blue Medical Form that we will be sending home that needs to be filled out and returned to the office before the end of the school year.
