TITLE: NETWORK/SYSTEMS ENGINEER

POSITION SUMMARY:

This individual provides support to the Assistant Superintendent of Operations as needed in addition to developing training and support of teaching staff in the use of technology integration and utilization. This individual also assists in the implementation of the system and building-level technology plans, working with principals and teachers to support building and district technology goals. This employee will be responsible for imaging and providing technology support for district used software.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. High school diploma or equivalent. Associates in related field preferred.
- 2. Criminal history clearance.
- 3. Valid Oregon Driver's License and evidence of insurability.
- 4. Demonstrated knowledge and skill supporting enterprise technology systems. Education experience preferred.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Plan and facilitate teaching and learning.
- 2. Collaborate with teachers and other instructional staff to develop support programs that allow classroom extension and support.
- 3. Model the integration of technology in all curriculum areas.
- 4. Facilitate school participation in technology programs and activities.
- 5. Conduct staff development in the areas of technology integration.
- 6. Collaborate with the school library media coordinator to provide leadership in the schools' use of instructional technology resources to enhance learning.
- 7. Follow a plan for professional development and actively seeks out opportunities to grow professionally.
- 8. Plan and facilitate information access and delivery.
- 9. Implement best practices related to technology use in the school program based on research, pilot programs, and state/national standards.
- 10. Independently research desktop-related issues and apply results of that research
- 11. Maintain effective interpersonal relationships with professional colleagues and members of the public.
- 12. Work harmoniously with others and communicate effectively (both orally and in writing) with students, parents, and/or staff as needed.
- 13. Work with the principals and schools leadership teams to provide support of assessment programs and tools.
- 14. Assist with the planning the design of the technology infrastructure so that information resources are continually available to the school community.
- 15. Adhere to and communicate copyrights as well as other laws and guidelines pertaining to the distribution and ethical use of all resources.
- 16. Assist in maintain hardware, software, and network infrastructure.
- 17. Provide leadership and collaborates with the Media and Technology Advisory Committee or site council, in order to develop, implement, and update a school instructional technology plan aligned with the system-level technology plan.
- 18. Collaborate with teachers, media, and technology staff, and students to evaluate and select resources addressing curricular needs and learning goals.
- 19. Lead in the ongoing evaluation of the effectiveness of the instructional technology program.
